Always warm up

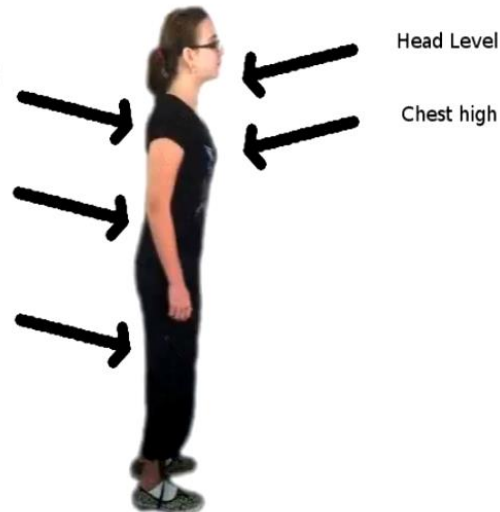
Listen carefully to people around you
